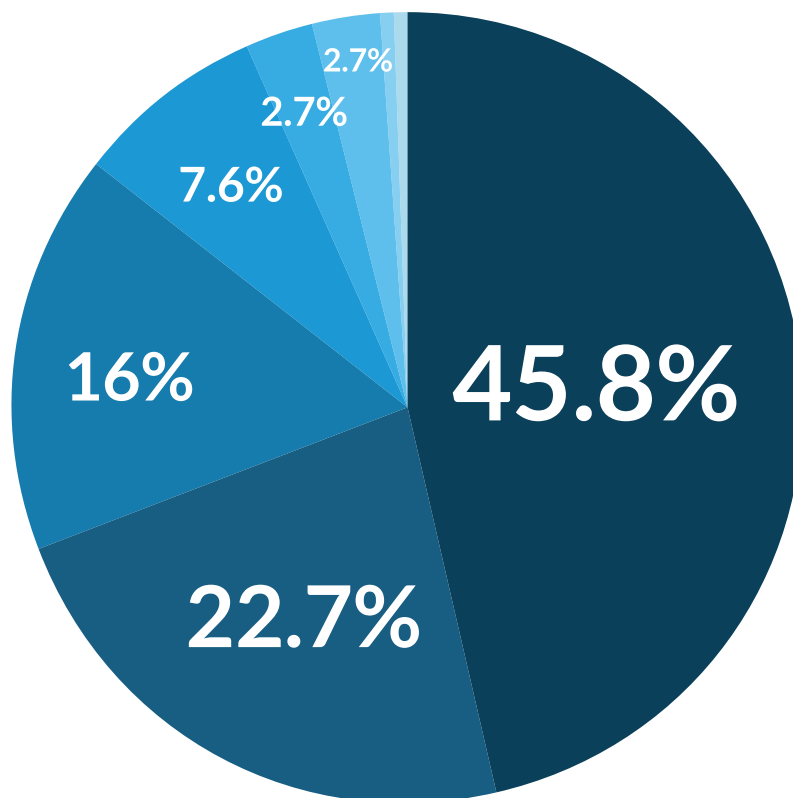

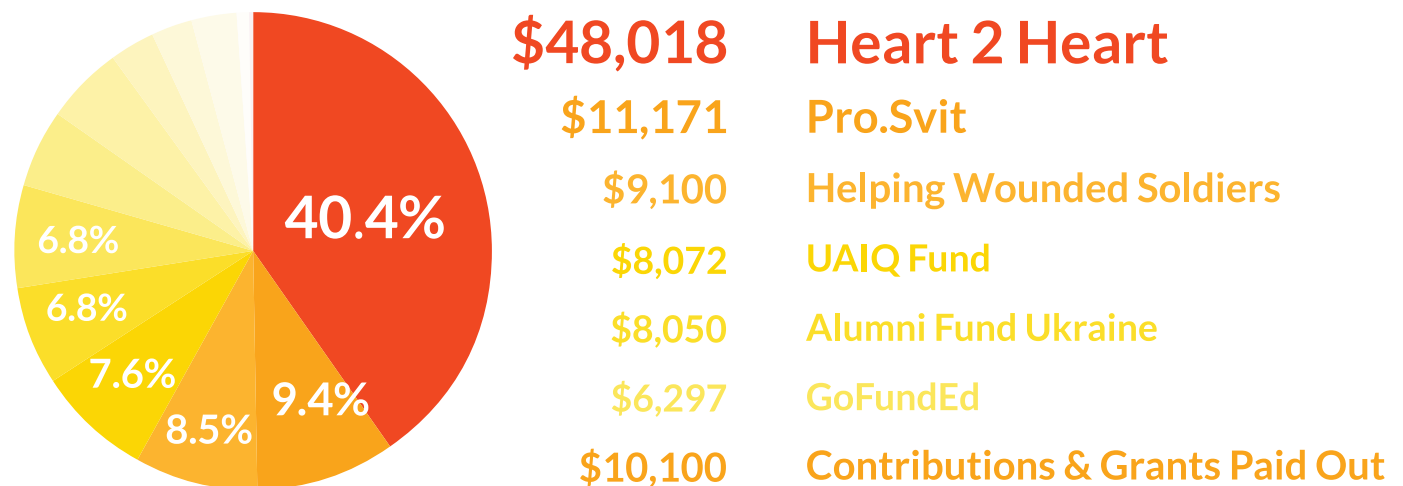
EXPENSES
